



# Unit Tour4B Circular Economy in Tourism Sector Accommodation and Food sector

(Case Studies/ Success Stories)

#### 1 Introduction

Unit 4B provides guidance for trainers looking to develop a short training programme on introducing sustainable practises to the accommodation/hotel sector to their students. The focus is on highlighting examples of different hotels and the initiatives that they have successfully applied to their hotel operation. It is important for the learner to understand the CE practices required for ensuring sustainability in the sector.

In the context of event management the level of knowledge, skills and competence your students will be expected to show will be as follows

- 3. For the students to be able to apply circular-economy principles to businesses in the accommodation and food sectors catering to tourists.





#### 3 Lesson Plan

The following table can be used as a template for structuring a training programme at level 4

Method		Suggested duration in minutes (total minutes)
	Present the PPTX file to the students. Ask the students to note which measures are common to several of the case study hotels.	30
Discussion	Break the students into small groups. Ask them to think about hotels or accommodation where they have worked, or stayed at a guest and consider what measures could support a more sustainable experience	60
Assessment	Quiz in the form of MCQs	15
