



Unit Tour6B Circular Economy in Tourism Sector Sustainable Event Management

(Case Studies/ Success Stories)

1 Introduction

Unit 2 provides guidance for trainers looking to develop a short training programme on introducing circular events management approach to their students. The focus is on highlighting examples of different successfully organized sustainable events to demonstrate how CE approach can be implemented in events management. It is important for the learner to understand the CE practices required for ensuring sustainability and circularity in events.

In the context of event management the level of knowledge, skills and competence your students will be expected to show will be as follows

- 3. For the students to be able to elaborate a discussion and argument for circular economy in events management with examples.
